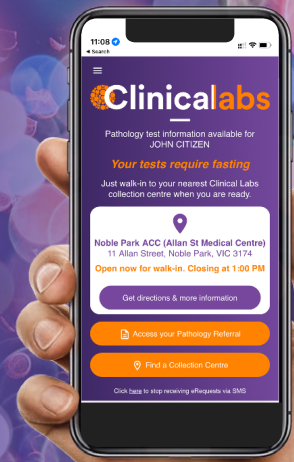


eRequests with Genie® and Gentu®

Get Started with eRequests

eRequests is free to use for Genie and Gentu users. Here's how to get started.

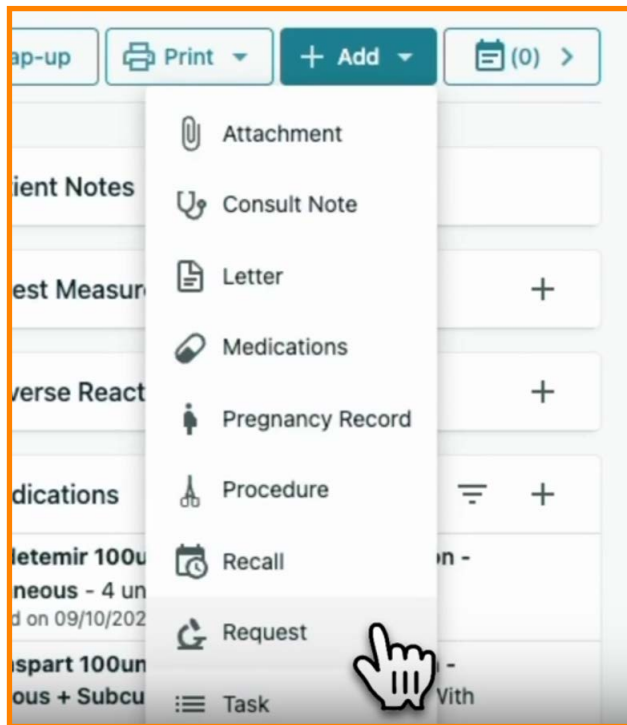
Gentu eRequests is available in Gentu and ready to use. To get set up, follow the steps on activating and configuring via the Gentu Knowledgebase.

Genie **v10.2.7 and above:** eRequests are built into the latest versions of Genie; no additional steps are needed.
v10.2.2 – v10.2.6: Follow the steps on activating and configuring for eRequests via the Genie Knowledgebase.
Below v10.2.2: You will need to upgrade to a newer version of Genie to start using eRequests.

How to send eRequests

eRequests is simple to use with Genie and Gentu, and for most users, it will be ready and waiting for you to start using. Here's where to find it within the Genie and Gentu interfaces:

Gentu

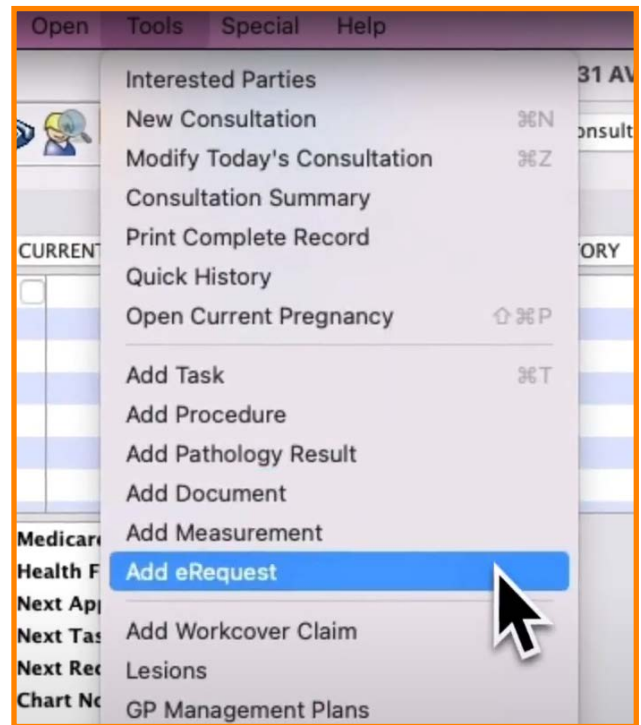
